>Current Residents - If you remove your fence, please remember you are required to have the yard up to standards after fence removal. After you have brought the yard up to standards, notify our office. We will inspect the yard. The grounds team will not start service for any yards in non-compliance, **this also includes feces present in rear area.**

>New Residents - If the fence is still up upon your move in & you don't want to keep, please contact our office. We will send notification to the fence company on your behalf.

>Pending Move Outs - Fence must be removed back up to standards, prior to your final out to avoid a fee for the yard upon move out.
