Holiday Safety Tips

More house fires occur on Christmas than any other day except Thanksgiving.

- Stand by your pan! Be mindful when cooking - it's easy to get distracted.
- Be extra cautious if using candles. Employ a one foot circle of safety with nothing within that could burn.
- Water live trees daily.
- Unplug lights before leaving the house or going to bed at night..
- Consider using LED lights which are cooler than other types.
- Develop and practice a home fire escape plan.
- Ensure your smoke and CO detectors are working. Initiate a maintenance request if you need assistance or are unsure. -
- Don't overload extension cord and don't run them under rugs or carpets - Ensure lights and cords used outside are rated for exterior use.
