Friendly Reminder Grilling Safety

- >Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- >The grill should be **placed 15 ft. away from the home, and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.**
- >Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill area.
- >Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- >Never leave your grill unattended.
- >Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it.

CHARCOAL GRILLS

- >There are several ways to get the charcoal ready to use. Charcoal chimney starters allow you to start the charcoal using newspaper as a fuel.
- >If you use a starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire.
- >Keep charcoal fluid out of the reach of children and away from heat sources.
- >There are also electric charcoal starters, which do not use fire. Be sure to use an extension cord for outdoor use.
- >When you are finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.
