This year, HMCF secured 2,314 backpacks filled with school supplies and will be distributing them throughout August to HMC communities within the continental U.S. and Hawaii.

Each year, Active Duty Service Member school-age children between the ages of who reside in Hunt Military Communities homes are eligible to register for a backpack. This program, in its third year, aims to alleviate some of the financial burden military families face when getting their children ready for school by providing backpacks with a variety of needed supplies, including pens, pencils, paper, scissors, and binders all tailored to the needs and grade levels of the children.

Keep your Pets Safe from the Heat

Fresh water, shade, and cool surfaces are essential. Never walk them during the mid-day or especially when it's hot; however, pavement can remain hot after sundown, paws will burn! Don't leave pets out in the backyard or in the garage for long periods.

Trim long-haired dogs, but never shave their coats. Don't leave pets in a parked car and don't rely on a fan to cool off your animal; fans do not cool animals as effectively as they cool humans.

Higher humidity means that it takes lower temperatures to develop excessive heat exposure symptoms.

Signs of Heat Exposure: Excessive panting, difficulty breathing, increased heart rate, drooling, bloody diarrhea, mild weakness, stupor, collapse, seizure, or vomiting.

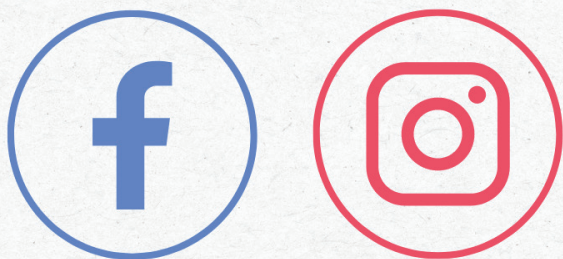
Fence Removal Information

After you have brought the yard up to standards, send notification along with pictures of all angles of the entire rear yard, including the flower beds and rock areas to NellisFamilyHousing@HuntCompanies.com include home address in the subject title.

The grounds team will not start service for any rear common areas in non-compliance; this also includes pet feces, or any personal items present upon their arrival.
